The Regional Knowledge Resource Kit (RKRK) www.rkrk.net.au is an interactive online resource for learning and developing skills in managing information and knowledge for regional NRM. It includes a stage-by-stage guide to preparing a Regional Knowledge Strategy and reference materials addressing a wide range of Information Management and Knowledge Management topics.
